# Three Phases

- There are three different phases that are included in the plan. They include:
- Phase 1
- Phase 2
- Phase 3

# Phase 1

- Under Phase 1, all K-5 students would return to school full-time following a traditional schedule where certain classes (Arts & Specials) will be modified under specific social distancing guidelines as recommended.

# Phase 2 (To be in place the start of the 2020-2021 School year)

Under Phase 2, students in the school building two days a week; three days a week will be remote learning:

- Session A (Monday & Tuesday for half of student enrollment in the building)
- Session B (Thursday & Friday for half of student enrollment in the building)

# Phase 3

Under Phase 3 all students would transition to Easton Arts Academy's fully remote/cyber instructional program and engage with teachers via daily live sessions as well as complete asynchronous activities.

# Fully Remote/Cyber Learning Option Also Available For Interested Families

- All families at Easton Arts Academy will have the option of sending their children back to school in-person on a modified schedule to begin the 2020-21 school year under “Phase 2” of the plan to reopen school.
- Easton Arts Academy’s very well received distance learning program last year (in response to the Pandemic) is an available option. Improvements have and are being made to our remote model for families who prefer to start the year fully remote and online.
- All families are requested to select the in-person or fully remote/cyber option for their student(s) by completing a registration process which will be sent to families and available on the website.



# Lunch Options

## Phase 1

- Classes/grades will alternate eating in cafeteria on a planned schedule.

## Phase 2

- Breakfast and lunch will be provided to our students.
- Students participating in online instruction will be provided with 10 meals
- The days that they are not in school meals will be provided for the 3 days

## Phase 3

- Option is being provided for parents to get meals from EAAECS if school is closed (once a week pick up for all meals).

# Transportation

- Protective measures will be in place at all times.
- Two students per seat, and siblings must sit together.
- Student will have assigned seats.
- All backpacks are to be kept closed at all times.
- All personal items are to remain in backpacks.
- Bus will be cleaned in between bus runs and at the end of the day.

# Health Considerations

- Students and staff with medical conditions will be monitored on case by case basis.
- Daily hand washing and deep cleaning will be in place.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be placed on every floor.
- School will be sanitized on a daily basis.
